Grocery Relief to Flood Victims

SKILL DEVELOPMENT

TAILORING



Tailoring has proven to be an effective and sustainable income-generating option for women with limited education and skills. To support this, numerous tailoring centers were established across various villages and locations, catering to interested community members.

The tailoring training program lasts for six months, with sessions held five days a week for two and a half hours each morning. Upon successful completion of the training, each participant is awarded a certificate.

To ensure a smooth learning process, the organization provides sewing machines and all necessary materials at the start of each batch. This initiative has empowered many women, offering them an opportunity to earn a livelihood while developing valuable skills.



SKILL DEVELOPMENT

TAILORING



- Community Empowerment through Skill Development:** The establishment of tailoring centers in various villages addresses the gap in formal education and employment opportunities for women. These centers create accessible avenues for women to learn a trade, thereby improving their economic stability and contributing to the overall empowerment of women in underserved communities.
- Structured Learning Approach:** The program's duration of six months, combined with five days of training each week, reflects a well-structured learning approach designed to provide participants with both theoretical knowledge and practical experience. The two-and-a-half-hour daily sessions ensure focused learning while allowing participants to balance family responsibilities.
- Supportive Learning Environment:** The provision of sewing machines and all required materials from the outset of the program underscores the organization's commitment to creating a fully supportive learning environment. This ensures that the participants have all the necessary tools to gain hands-on experience and complete the training successfully.
- Certification and Recognition:** Upon completion of the training, participants are awarded a certificate, which not only serves as recognition of their skills but also increases their employability or ability to start their own tailoring businesses. This certification can be a crucial step towards further economic opportunities for these women.


